SUPPLIER REGISTRATION SYSTEM

SUPPLIERS REGISTRATION

The purpose is to gather more information about our suppliers and contractors to encourage long-term business relationships that support a reliable, transparent and efficient supply chain system.

Strengthen strategic sourcing and category management, as well as reduce time in selection and contracting procedures through reliable information on current or potential suppliers and contractors, as well as control and reduce risk in the supply chain by analyzing their capabilities.

WHY REGISTER?

Registration is important to ensure all buyers and other areas related with business or procurement processes, have visibility of the products and services your company can provide and therefore enables buyers to match these with the business needs of Pemex.

REGISTRATION LEVELS:

INITIAL

This is the first step for suppliers that have never had a contract with PEMEX. It allows them to provide general and commercial information about their company, as well as the products or services they offer. This registration is free and requires completing a short questionnaire enabling PEMEX to gain an initial understanding of the supplier's offering.

COMPLEMENTARY

This registration is by invitation only. It applies to suppliers with current or previous PEMEX contracts and must be kept up to date.

Complementary registration is mandatory in the following scenarios:

1. Direct Award Procedures:
 - Applicable except for contracts involving smaller amounts.
 - Applies for all suppliers that are part of a Legal Contracting Instrument
2. Formalization of Contractual Alliances
3. Contracts Resulting from:
 - Tenders
 - Restricted Tenders



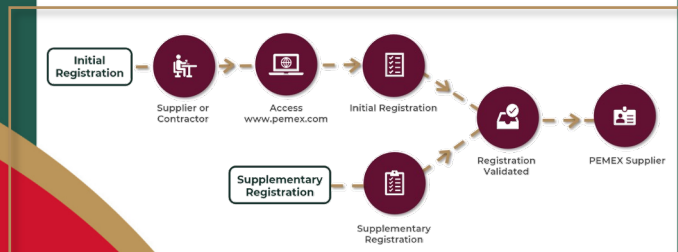
